

Application Memo Factor of Silver Nitrate

Industry	Inorganic chemical industry
Instrument	Automatic potentiometric titrator
Measurement method	Acid-base titration

1. Overview

Factor measurement of 0.1mol/L silver nitrate solution is specified by JIS K 8001-2017 “General rules for test methods of reagents”. The diluted sodium chloride is titrated with 0.1mol/L silver nitrate up to the endpoint, which is the maximum inflection on the titration curve. The factor for standardization of 0.1mol/L silver nitrate solution is calculated from the titration volume of silver nitrate.


2. Apparatus

Main unit	Automatic potentiometric titrator (preamplifier STD)
Electrode	Combined silver electrode

3. Reagents

Titrant	0.1mol/L silver nitrate solution
Solvent	Pure water
Reference	Sodium chloride
